Rosen Shingle Creek Floor Plan

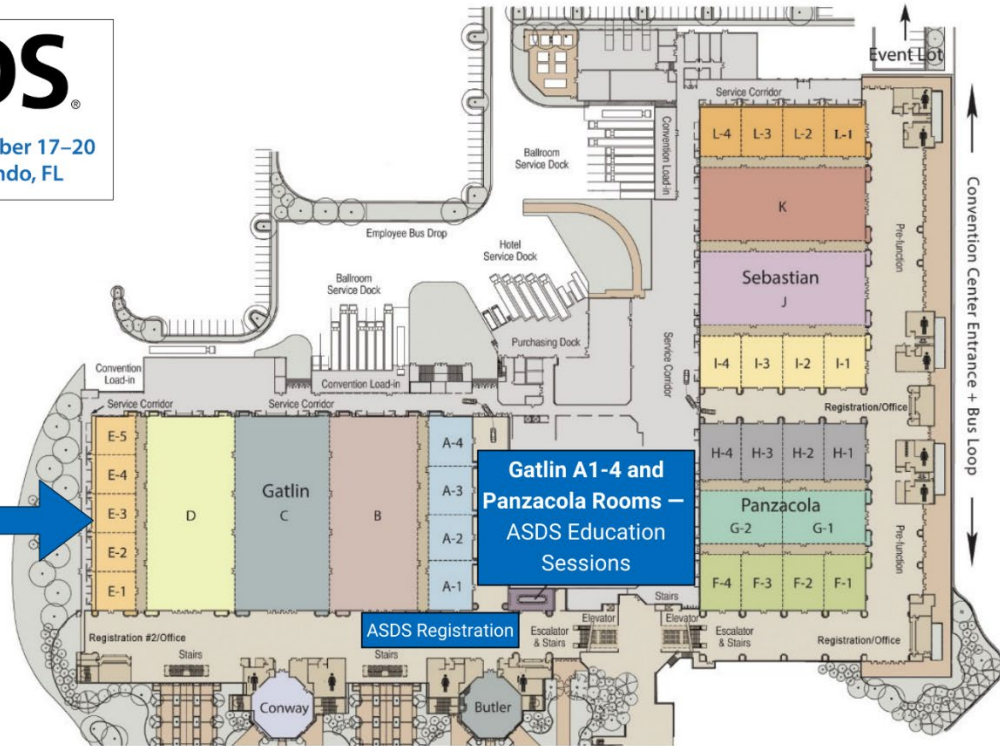
