Resident Scholarships being awarded:

- 1. ASDS awards scholarships of \$750 to 266 third-year dermatology residents in an approved training program (graduating May 2019 through July 2020). If you have received this scholarship in a previous year, you will be waitlisted. However, be sure to apply as most applicants receive scholarships as they become available.
- 2. The Vic Narurkar, MD, Resident Scholarship will pay all expenses for one resident towards the 2019 ASDS Annual Meeting. In the essay portion below, please share why you should be selected and how you see aesthetics as part of your future and the future of dermatology.

Awards must be applied toward direct costs of attending the 2019 ASDS Annual Meeting including registration fees, hotel, airfare and incidental costs (cab, parking and/or meal expenses). To be reimbursed, you must check-in onsite at the ASDS registration. If you fail to do so, actual receipts of all expenses incurred must be submitted to ASDS by 12/2/19. Applicants will be notified of their status within two weeks of application receipt.

You must register for the meeting by Sept. 18 and check-in onsite at the meeting by Friday, Oct. 25 at 9 a.m.
