Dr. Jeremy Bordeaux currently serves as Director- Mohs and Dermatologic Surgery, Director- Multidisciplinary Cutaneous Oncology Program, and Fellowship Director- Micrographic Surgery and Dermatologic Oncology at University Hospitals Cleveland Medical Center. In addition he is Professor of Dermatology at Case Western Reserve University. Dr. Bordeaux received the Theodore Tromovitch Award, Career Development award in Dermatologic Surgery from the Dermatology Foundation, and a Cutting Edge research Award for the ASDS. He has served the ASDS as a member of the Board of Directors, as Chair of the Patient Education Workgroup, as Chair of the Task Force on Value Analysis, as alternate advisor to the CPT, as a Future Leaders Program Mentor, as a member of the Audit Committee and as a member of the skin cancer patient experience task force. He has served as an assistant editor for the Dermatologic Surgery Journal and editorial board member of JAMA dermatology. He also has served on the Board of Directors for the American College of Mohs Surgery and the Board of Directors for the Association of Professors of Dermatology. He has published over 100 manuscripts and given over 160 national/international presentations. His area of expertise include advanced reconstruction of Mohs defects and skin cancer epidemiology and treatment.
