He is the editor of six cosmetic and laser surgery textbooks, including his own textbook on surgical reconstruction. He has been the guest editor of the *Seminars in Cutaneous Medicine and Surgery* and the *Skin Cancer Foundation Journal*, and is an Associate editor of *Dermatologic Surgery*. Along with his partners, Drs. Arndt, Dover, and Kaminer, Dr. Rohrer co-directs three fellowships each year that focus on all aspects of dermatologic surgery. Together they have graduated over 50 well-trained dermatologic surgeons who have gone on to exceptional careers across the country. Dr. Rohrer has been elected to the board of directors of the American Academy of Dermatology, the American Society for Dermatologic Surgery, the American College of Mohs Surgery, the American Society for Laser Medicine and Surgery, and the Association of Academic Dermatologic Surgeons.

Dr. Rohrer is a past President of the American Society for Dermatologic Surgery. He has also been the Scientific Chair of the Annual Meetings of the American College of Mohs Surgery, the American Society for Dermatologic Surgery, and the American Society for Laser Medicine and Surgery.
